SCHOLASTIC BOOK ORDERS

All orders are processed at the end of each month, so the September orders will be due by noon on Monday, September 30th. The October fliers will be sent home in your child's Friday Folders. All fliers are good for 3 months, so if you miss the deadline, you can still use the fliers. Can't find your fliers? All fliers are available online for all grades. In September, if we have \$300 or more in orders, we will get 10,000 bonus points.

You can place orders on-line by going to scholastic.com/readingclub and enter Mrs. Fosnes' activation code M9RG8 for K & 2-8, and GRGCY for 1st grade only or fill out the paper order form and give them to Mrs. Fosnes (for all grades) with a check payable to Scholastic (no cash please). Mrs. Fosnes works in Kids Klub in the morning or your child can find her in the library during the school day. Your child's books will be given to your child.
