Dear Middle School Families,

All Redeemer middle school students are expected to read at least one novel over the summer. Research has proven that summer reading is important for children as a means of preventing a "summer slide" in their skills. However, through the years we have found that when students are forced to read a book that they have not self-selected, they read with less enthusiasm and often do not immerse themselves into the novel. As a means to help encourage and foster the love of reading, we are allowing each middle school student to self-select their summer reading book. The book must be at least 150 pages in length, and it needs to be a book they have not read before (and cannot be a movie version- it can be a book that was turned into a movie, however the movie storyline may not be used in the assignment). Each student is expected to complete the attached summer reading assignment and turn in the completed pages to their Language Arts class on Monday, August 26, 2019. We do recommend that parents review the titles and content and assist their child in selecting a novel that is suitable for the student. Students may read more than one book, and if they do so, they only need to complete the summer reading assignment for one of the books they read. (You may complete the assignment on the attached packet or type and print.)
